### AWARD QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Applicants **must be** one of the following:
  - a. A member in good standing of Law Enforcement Explorer Post 411
  - b. An employee or dependent spouse or child of an employee of the Pearland Police Department.
  - A member in good standing or dependent spouse, or child of a member in good stand standing of the Pearland Citizens Police Academy Alumni Association (PCPAAA).

That has been accepted for enrollment at an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy, or an accredited trade or technical school.

- 2. Applicants must submit all of the following prior to the start of the next academic semester for which the applicant will attend school:
  - a. A completed Education Award Application form.
  - b. letter of acceptance from or proof of current enrollment at an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy, or an accredited trade or technical school.
  - c. Applicant will provide proof of a minimum GPA of 2.5 if the applicant is currently enrolled in high school, or is a high school graduate and has not started undergraduate studies. Provide proof of an equivalent type GPA of 2.5 high school which is accepted by the Educational Award Committee or proof of a minimum GPA 2.5 if the applicant has started undergraduate studies at an accredited college, university, or regional law enforcement academy, or an accredited trade or technical school.
  - d. 300 600 word essay on one of the following topics:
    - i. Police community relations
    - ii. Law enforcements role in American society
    - iii. Police professionalism
    - iv. The law enforcement code of ethics
    - v. The effects of a law enforcement career on family

- 3. Scholarships are awarded in the amount and not to exceed \$500 per semester per applicant.
- 4. An applicant may receive a lifetime cumulative total of not more than four Education awards.
- All application material becomes the property of the Pearland Citizens Police Academy Alumni Association (PCPAAA) and shall not be returned to the applicant.
- Pearland Citizens Police Academy Alumni Association (PCPAAA) will make every effort to make a timely Education Award decision will be made prior to the applicants next semester of study or within any other time frame.
